Dear Contestant,

Welcome to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Pageant! We would like to share with you a few important dates. Please mark your calendar accordingly!

The Queen's Luncheon, which is to honor our current title holders, Sophia Brescoach and Rileigh Fortney, will be held on **Sunday August 6TH**. This luncheon will be held at the **Mannington Elks Lodge**. If you should need directions please contact Michele Wilson-Smith or Melissa Angelucci (their numbers are listed below!). The luncheon will begin 3:00pm.

Our practice will be held on **Sunday August 6TH**. The practice will be at the stage on the fair grounds. We ask that you bring the shoes you would like to practice in. Please note the practice will begin shortly after the luncheon. We are giving everyone about an hour to go from the _Mannington Elks Lodge to the stage. This should give everyone plenty of time to be ready for practice to begin right at 6:00pm.

The parade will be held on **Monday August 7th**. The line-up will be at The First Exchange Bank. You should see a Parade Marshall that can direct you to where exactly you will need to line up. This is a good meeting place for everyone to adjust and get their number in the parade line. Should you not spot someone right away, they usually wear shirts that say Parade Marshall, on the back. So, look for them!

All paperwork is due by July 31st. Please make sure your paper work is turned in. This gives us plenty of time to prepare the judges books. We would love to be able to allow the contestants a chance to look at the completed judges books on Sunday. It's very important that all documents are turned in on time. If, for any reason, you are not able to have everything turned in PLEASE contact Michele Wilson or Melissa Angelucci as soon as you realize you may need more time.

You should turn in: Contract, Resume, All About Me, and Entry Fee. Please note that the contract will need to be notarized.

You will also need to submit a bio and a wallet sized photo to the Times WV by July 30th for it to make the Sunday paper on August 6th.

The pageant will be held on Tuesday August 8TH at 8:00PM. The interviews will begin earlier that day. We will give you the specific time of your interview at practice on Sunday. The time will be determined on how many contestants we have.

July 31st: All paperwork is due. Please contact Michele Wilson-Smith or Melissa Angelucci to arrange how the paperwork will be submitted. Melissa will be more than happy to meet with girls at a convenient time to get the paperwork.

August 6TH: Luncheon to honor our current title holders, Sophia Brescoach and Rileigh Fortney. The luncheon will be from 3:00pm-5:00pm.

August 6th: Practice will begin at 6:00pm. Please arrive on time. It is important to begin promptly at 6:00pm.

August 7TH: The parade lineup will be at The First Exchange Bank.

Introduction: The dress you wear in the parade will be worn for introductions.

Fair Promo: Jeans with a tee shirt that will be provided.

On-Stage Question: The outfit you wear for your private interview.

Streetwear: Floral Print. Make this an outfit you LOVE!

Private Interview: Consider this an interview to your dream job. Dress to impress!

Parade: The Queen and Junior Miss will be wearing a gown. The contestants should arrive in a cocktail dress.

Section 1: Introduction

1.1.1. The Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee is a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of West Virginia. The Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee has operated a program offering scholarship assistance and career opportunities for the young women within the town of Mannington and the County of Marion. In doing so, The Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee has made substantial investments in, and has developed a valuable identity for the unique symbols and elements of the program that have achieved national and even international recognition and approval. These elements include but are not limited to (1) providing educational assistance in the form of scholarships to young adult women who have not yet begun to assume the responsibilities of family life and are interested in career and educational advancement; (2) recognizing and honoring the traits of honesty, good character, talent poise, intellect, leadership and good judgment in the young women of West Virginia who enter the competition (the "Contestants"); and (3) enabling the Contestants to serve as role models for other young women with similar goals and personal characteristics.

1.2. The Mannington District Fair Queen Committee intends to conduct a competition for the title "Miss Mannington District Fair Queen" to be held in Mannington on _____ . The competition is a critically important, and the single most visible and widely recognized element of the Program. The competition is conducted in a fashion that is designed to combine a respect for the traditional and historic foundations

of the Program with recognition of the perceived modern tastes and values of the American people.

1.3.1. The winner of the competition shall be designated “Miss Mannington District Fair Queen, and shall be entitled to that title until her successor is named at the competition. During this period (the “Year of Service”, the duties of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen may include travel and participation in personal appearances throughout the tri-county. These activities are designed, scheduled, arranged and supervised by the Miss Mannington District Fair Committee in order to reflect the values and standards of the Program and to enhance its visibility and maintain its broad public acceptance. The Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee has also developed detailed procedures that govern the activities and conduct of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen during her Year of Service. These procedures and standards are intended to protect and enhance the substantial public acceptance of the Program among the WV people, and to assure that the program will continue to be able to operate for the benefit of the hundreds of young women who will be seeking to participate in the Program in future years.

1.3.2. In seeking to participate in the competition, each Contestant must understand and accept the requirements of the Program, including the rules for the contestants and the guidelines and limitations that will be applicable to her activities during her Year of Service if she is selected as Miss Mannington District Fair Queen. In addition, each Contestant must understand and accept that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee approval of the Contestant’s participation in the competition and, if selected, service as Miss Mannington District Fair Queen will be specifically based upon the representations and agreements in the Application and Contract and its attachments and the continued compliance with all of the regulations of the Program. In such regard, I acknowledge that my ability to compete in the pageant shall be subject to review at each level of competition that I enter and that the determination of my eligibility to compete in the competition shall not in and of itself be the basis of my eligibility to compete in the Local and/or State Finals.

1.3.3. Therefore, by signing this Application and Contract and submitting it to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee for approval, the Contestant represents and agrees that (1) all facts and representations contained in the Application and Contract and its attachments are true and accurate; (2) the Contestant agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee described in this Application and Contract and its attachments, in the period before and during the Year of Service; and (3) the Contestant meets each requirement for eligibility set forth in Section 2 of the Contract; and (4) the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall have the sole discretion to determine whether, in its judgment, the Contestant may continue to participate in the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Program, in the event that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee determines that any statement or representation by the Contestant is not true and accurate or that any action by the contestant is inconsistent with the rules and regulations of the Program.

Section 2: Eligibility of Contestant to Participate in the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Program

2.1. AGE: I am currently ____ years of age. I was born on _____, 19____. I understand that in order to be eligible to compete, I must: (1) be 16 before the first day of the Mannington District Fair and (2) be no older than 21 January 1 in the year following the Mannington District Fair.

2.2. RESIDENCE: I understand that, in order to compete in the Local or State pageant in anticipation of this year's state finals, I must reside in; or be enrolled in and physically attending classes on a full-time basis in Marion County.

2.3. CITIZENSHIP: I am a citizen of the United States of America

2.4. EDUCATION: In order to be eligible to compete, I must be enrolled as a full time student.

2.5. PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: I understand that in order to be eligible to compete in the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen competition, I hereby certify to the Personal Characteristics set forth in this section:

2.5.1 GENDER: I am and I have always been a female

2.5.2 MARITAL STATUS: I am not now and I have never been married, nor have I had a marriage annulled.

2.5.3 PARENTAL STATUS: I am not now pregnant, and I have never been pregnant. I am not the adoptive parent of any child, nor will I become the adoptive parent of any child during my Year of Service.

2.5.4 GOOD CHARACTER: I am of good moral character and I have not been involved at any time in any act of moral turpitude or behavior that is, or could be, perceived by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee as contrary to the Fair Queen Program or its elements as previously described.

2.5.5 CRIMINAL RECORD: I have not been charged with multiple minor or petty offenses in the last twenty-four months. I have never been convicted of any criminal

offense and there are no criminal charges presently pending against me.

2.5.6 PRIOR CONDUCT: I have never, knowingly or unknowingly, performed any act or engaged in any activity or employment that is or the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee could characterize as dishonest, immoral, lewd, or indecent.

2.5.7 HEALTH: I am in good health and can, to the best of my knowledge, participate fully in any and all Program activities. Any current medical condition or disability will not impede my ability to compete in all activities of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen competition, complete my Year of Service or fulfill my obligations under the Agreement or require unreasonable or exceptional assistance as determined solely by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee. Upon the request of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee will provide or cause my health care providers to provide the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee with all or a portion of my health care records as necessary to verify the accuracy of this representation.

2.5.8 SUBSTANCE ABUSE: I do not use or consume any illegal or controlled substances other than those obtained pursuant to a valid prescription and taken according to the directions of a licensed health care professional. I do not abuse the use of alcohol, prescriptive drugs or other dangerous substances.

2.6 Contractual and Other Obligation

2.6.1 OTHER COMPETITIONS: If I win, I will continue to hold the title of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen until my successor is selected or appointed. I agree that, during my service in that role and until after the scheduled completion of the full term of the position of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen for which I was selected, I will not associate in any way with, promote, judge or become a contestant or participant in any other fair or festival. I also represent that since I received my title Miss Mannington District Fair Queen in competition for the title of Miss Mannington District

Fair Queen I will only represent the Mannington District Fair in the West Virginia Association of Fairs and Festivals pageant.

2.6.2 Use of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, Titles, Words, and Symbols.

After the conclusion of my year of service, if I am advised by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee that, in its sole and exclusive judgment, my use of any of the titles, words or symbols associated with the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, the Mannington District Fair, and the Program has caused or is reasonably likely to cause harm, I agree to discontinue any such use immediately. I understand and agree that the judgment of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall be final and binding.

2.6.3 If selected Miss Mannington District Fair Queen, my actions and conduct will be representative of the integrity and esteem of the Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, I acknowledge that I am an official representative of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee and I will not engage in any actions or behavior that could be perceived by the Miss Mannington Fair Queen Committee as contrary to the Program or its elements.

2.6.4 Attorney Review of Application and Contract: I have been given sufficient opportunity to review this application and contract and its attachments, including the supplemental fact sheet. I have also had the opportunity to consult with an attorney of my own choosing to give me legal advice with regard to this application and contract. I understand that this application and contract is a legal document and that if I sign and submit it to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee and it is accepted, I have agreed to be bound by the application and contract and its attachments.

2.6.5 Changes in Circumstances: I understand and agree that if, at any time after I file this application and contract with the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, including my year of service, any of the fact stated in the application and contract or its

attachments including but not limited to those related to my ability to fully participate in all activities should change at any time, I am obligated to report any such change in writing immediately to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee. I also understand that if I fail to do so, the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee may, in its sole discretion, determine to limit or prevent my participation or to terminate my year of service as Miss Mannington District Fair Queen.

2.6.6. Social Media: I understand that my social media will be monitored by members of the Mannington District Fair Committee. I understand that should I post anything to any type of social media account that is deemed inappropriate I will be asked to remove it from the said media outlet. I agree that should I be asked to remove more than two (2) posts/pictures I will then have a scheduled meeting with members of the committee to discuss an improvement plan and understand that I can lose my title.

Section 4: Participation in the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Competition

4.1 Participation in Competition: I agree to participate in the series of events and appearances leading up to the final selection of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Program. These events are scheduled on dates to be determined by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee. I will be bound by the rules and regulations governing the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee and the procedures for the awarding and supervision of all scholarships described in Attachment D. My participation in the competition may include public appearances scheduled for me by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee including, but not limited to, television and radio broadcasts, personal appearances, interviews, still photo sessions, and video and audio taping or filming of all or any part of the events associated with the competition.

4.2 Conduct of the Competition: I understand and agree that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall determine the manner and method of conducting the competition in its sole discretion. I further understand and agree that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall also determine the time, method and manner of judging the competition and the awarding and supervision of all scholarships in its sole discretion. The decision of the persons designated by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee to judge the various events in any and all matters pertaining to the selection of the winners shall be final in all respects.

4.3 Televising and Sponsorship of Competition: I understand that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee makes no representations to me that the competition will be televised or broadcast on either a live or tape-delay basis, or that the competition will be sponsored by one or more sponsors, or that I will be personally or individually involved in any specific appearance in any broadcast.

4.4 Selection as Runner-Up: If I am selected at the competition as a runner-up for the title of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen, I agree to remain available to assume all of the rights, obligations and commitments of the year of service, as described in this application and contract, in the event that the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee appoints me to do so by reason of the inability or ineligibility, during the year of service, of any contestant who was selected as Miss Mannington District Fair Queen or as another runner-up.

4.5 Change in Circumstances: I understand that if, at any time between the date of the application and contract and the completion of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen competition, any facts concerning my eligibility to participate in the competition should change, including without limitation my ability to participate fully in all contestant activities, citizenship, marital or parental status, good character and reputation of behavior that is, or could be, perceived as contrary to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Program or its elements as described in this contract or, if relevant to my eligibility, my residence, employment or educational status, the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to determine that I am not eligible to participate in competition.

Section 5: Legal Obligations and Agreements

5.1 Unauthorized Use of Titles: I acknowledge and agree that the title Miss Mannington District Fair Queen that I presently hold is to be solely used for purposes of promoting the Mannington District Fair and I will not promote the title for any other purposes.

5.2 Scholarship Grants and Forfeitures: I understand and agree that the grant of scholarships by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee is subject to the terms and conditions of the Scholarship rules and regulations attached to this application and contract. By signing this document, I agree to be bound by those rules and regulations. I understand that all scholarships that I may be awarded will be nonforfeitable in the event that I breach this contract or fail to perform any duties that I may have as a contestant. I also understand and agree, however, that such scholarships may be forfeited if I have made any misrepresentations as to my eligibility to compete. I understand that if I do not provide the appropriate documentation within three (3) years of obtaining my title, I will forfeit all winnings.

5.3 Termination of Eligibility. I understand and agree that if:

5.3.1 any of the representations or statements made by me in this application and contract or any of its attachments is determined by the Miss Mannington District Fair

Queen Committee to be false;

5.3.2 there is a change of circumstances that would affect my eligibility to participate fully in the competition or to complete my year of service, including without limitation changes in my ability to participate in all activities, citizenship, marital or parental status, good character and reputation or, behavior that is or the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee perceives as contrary to the Mannington District Fair Queen Program or its elements as described in this contract, or if relevant to my eligibility to participate in the competition, my residence, employment or educational status;

5.3.3 I fail to conduct myself in a manner which, in the sole and exclusive judgment of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee is consistent with the standards and dignity of the program; or

5.3.4 I do not abide by the Rules for the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee set forth in this contract and the guidelines and limitations that will be applicable to my activities if I am selected as Miss Mannington District Fair Queen.

5.3.5 I suffer any medical condition or disability, which, in the sole and exclusive judgment of the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee impairs my ability to perform the duties, expected of me as a contestant. The Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee shall have the right, in its sole and exclusive judgment, to determine that I am not eligible to participate or continue to participate in the competition or to complete my year of service. In that event, all titles awards, a perquisites of my position as a contestant, as appropriate, shall be terminated and forfeited, subject to the provisions of this application and contract.

5.4 Public Release of Information. I understand that some elements of the program, and in particular the competition and the public appearances of Miss Mannington District Fair Queen during the year of service, are frequently the subject of public interest and

scrutiny. I further understand that it is very important for the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee to maintain a high level of public trust in and acceptance of the integrity of, and manner of conducting, the competition and the qualifications and conduct of contestants. Accordingly, I authorize the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, in the exercise of its sole and exclusive discretion to release and to comment publicly upon any truthful information concerning my eligibility or continued eligibility to participate or to complete my year of service.

5.5 Entire Agreement; Enforceability. When signed and approved by the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee, the application and contract, together with its attachments, shall solely and exclusively determine my rights, privileges and responsibilities to the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee. No oral or other written statement that is in any way inconsistent with the provisions of this application and contract shall be binding upon me or upon the Miss Mannington District Fair Queen Committee. If any provision of this application and contract should be declared void or unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed omitted from this application and contract. In that event, the remainder of this application and contract shall remain in full force and effect.
